Dear parents,

As the term progresses quickly towards the next holidays, it is wonderful that so many students are in their classes and learning every day. Most of our students have not been involved in any major incidents and are participating in their classes with enthusiasm and good learning habits. Thank you to the parents/carers and families who make sure your children attend school everyday to maximise their learning.

Hats

Our school is a sunsafe school and for many years there has been a policy of "no hat, no play". All students were given a new school hat in 2017 and our new students, Kinder and preschool are given a hat when they commence at our school. If students lose their hat, they need to purchase a new one.

We do wash and recycle hats when students leave the school. .

Recently, there are a number of students not wearing a hat and some students take the hats of others which causes issues between them.

Over the next few weeks we will be checking on the hats and trying to locate the hats of all current students.

We would appreciate it if you could support us by discussing this with your child/children and reinforce the importance of wearing a hat for sun protection and good health.

Lost Property

Heating/Cooking of Lunches

We wish to advise that due to health and safety reasons, we cannot heat food in the community room for students or add boiling water to cups of noodles. Please make sure that your child's lunch is easy to eat in the classroom and doesn't require cooking or heating.

Noodles could be sent in a small thermos from home which would be much safer.

Some hot food is sold from the canteen and delivered safely in lunch baskets.

We thank you for your co operation in this matter and ensuring that our students are safe.

Local Area permission note

Most students in most classes have returned their local area permission note which is a wonderful effort and we thank you. If you haven't returned the local area note for your child, please send it in this week. If you have misplaced it, we can send another note home – just ask the teacher.

This note covers permission to attend events and excursions within the local area of Coonamble. Information will be sent home for every event so that parents have times, dates and details but actual permission to participate is covered by the local area note.

Parents & carers always have the right to withdraw permission at any time or to ask for their child not to participate in an individual activity/event. Also medical information needs to be updated if it changes throughout the year.

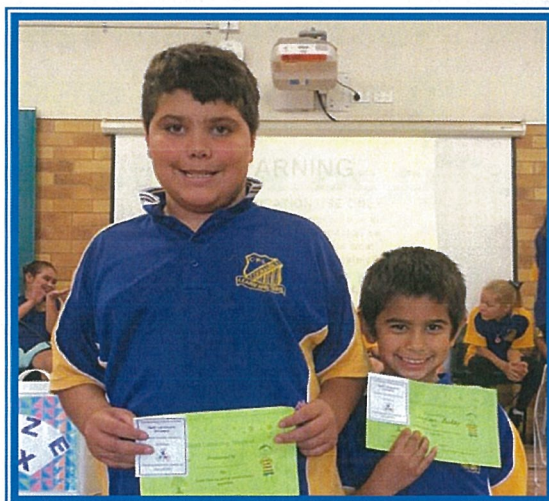

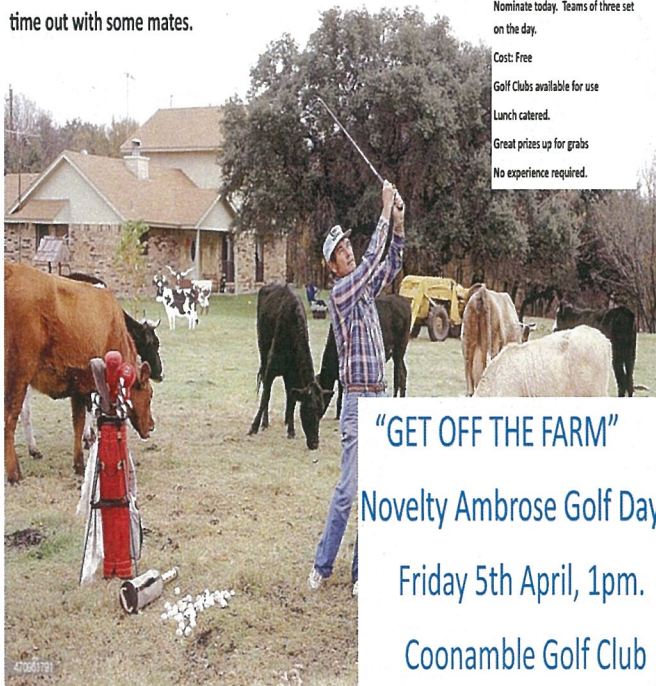
For the safety of students, please note the change in the bus/walkers gate which is located between the carparks.
