Gates

Following a serious incident with a near miss on the road for one of our support students, our gates are locked during the day except for the gate into the office. As parents you need to know that your students are as safe as possible when they are at school. The carpark gates are locked at 8.30am each day and the walkers gate through the canteen is locked at 9.00am and opened at 2.40pm in the afternoon to allow parents to collect students.

Following the incident, we are making a **slight change to this routine for the walkers gate** into the canteen. **It will be unlocked at 2.40pm but not opened. If you are coming to collect your children, please open the gate but close it behind you.** There is a temporary sign on the gate at the moment until we get a permanent sign.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation, I know that the safety of every student in our school is important to everyone and these rules only exist to try and keep everyone safe.

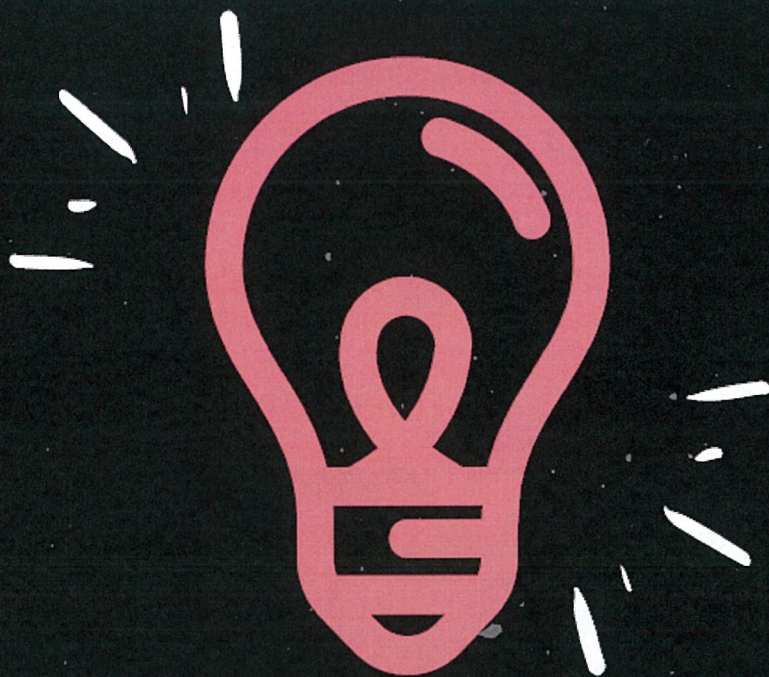
Staffing
